H. Pylori Antigen



Obtain a stool container from the laboratory.

The container should be a clean sterile cup with a leak-proof cap.

Instructions for Collection:

- 1. Diapers are not acceptable for specimen collection. To collect a stool specimen from a child in diapers, line the diaper with plastic wrap, collect the stool, and transfer to the collection container.
- 2. Collect the specimen in a clean specimen pan, plastic bag, or plastic wrap placed over the toilet seat. Avoid contaminating the stool specimen with urine or water during collection.
- 3. Transfer 15 grams of soft or liquid stool to the specimen cup (formed stool is not acceptable). Close the cap tightly.
- 4. Label the container (not the lid) with patient name, date of birth, and date/time of collection.
- 5. Keep refrigerated and deliver to lab within 72 hours of collection.
