

UPDATE: Changes to Rapid HIV Ordering and Reporting

Effective June 17, 2025, Rapid HIV orderables and reporting will change. This testing is performed at Legacy Emanuel, Salmon Creek, and Silverton Medical Centers. No changes to specimen requirements will occur.

The changes are:

- 1.) Orderable and name will change. We currently have two orderables that are identical except for the name. The new test will only have one orderable. Refer to Table 1 for more information.
- 2.) The current test only reports one result for Rapid HIV-Ag/Ab Interp as *Reactive* or *Non-reactive*. The new test will report results for three components. Either *Prelim Reactive* or *Non-reactive* will be reported for HIV-1 p24 Antigen, HIV-1/2 Antibody, and the RHIV Ab/Ag Interp. This change was made to standardize reporting of results across all testing facilities. The interpretive comments were modified slightly to match.
- 3.) Legacy Employee Health will now receive Rapid HIV results both as an automated fax and in Labcorp Link.
