### **LITHOLINK TESTING**

The Litholink test requires 24 hour urine collection and possible blood draw. The collection kit for urine is provided by LabCorp. The blood draw can be performed at a NorthShore Lab Service site.

<u>Litholink Description:</u> Litholink offers 24-hour urine testing for kidney stone prevention. Through sophisticated algorithms, Litholink provides quality test result with patient specific treatment recommendations.

# Physician Responsibility:

- Print Litholink form, (Litholink Form) to be completed by physician
- Provide patient with a written lab order or Epic lab order for urine and blood for Litholink urine and blood tests associated by Litholink.
- Complete Litholink form and ask patient to send form with urine specimen to Litholink and go to the lab for blood tests.
- Follow up with patient after results have been received

## Patient Responsibility:

# Urine Specimen

- Make a copy of the written order (not needed if order is in Epic)
- Request an at-home kit through LabCorp's patient portal at the following link: <a href="https://patient.labcorp.com/litholink">https://patient.labcorp.com/litholink</a>
- Litholink 24 hours urine bottle is not provided at NorthShore sites.
- Follow instructions for urine collection and return urine specimen and documents with the Litholink kit.

### Blood specimen

Present at a NorthShore drawing location with the copy of written lab (not needed if order is in Epic)

### NorthShore University HealthCare Responsibility:

- Register patient and enter the written lab order for blood tests in Epic. If the lab order for blood tests is available in Epic, release the lab order.
- Collect specimen and forward to Evanston lab

### Litholink Responsibility:

- Send patient the at-home kit as requested on the Litholink Patient portal
- Complete urine testing and deliver results to provider
- Bill patient or insurance directly
