Saliva Cortisol Collection Instructions for Patients

Kit Contents:



- Salivette Collection Tube (blue cap)
 - Sterile swab inside tube

Patient Preparation:

- Recommended collection time is between 11:00 pm and 1:00 am
- Do NOT collect specimen:
 - o within 60 minutes of eating a meal
 - o within 12 hours after consuming alcohol
 - o immediately after brushing teeth or any activity that may cause gums to bleed
- Rinse mouth thoroughly with water 10 minutes before specimen collection
- Label the tube:
 - o with your full name and
 - o date of birth and
 - o date and time you collected the sample
- Wash your hands before starting

Specimen Collection:

Remove the blue cap so you can see the swab



• Tip the tube to empty the swab into your mouth without touching it



- Keep the swab in your mouth for 2-3 minutes to completely saturate it with saliva
 - o The swab should be under the tongue or
 - Allowed to move freely across the tongue or
 - Gently chew the swab

Note: Do not place the swab between cheek and gum

Return the swab to the Salivette tube without touching it



- Firmly place the blue cap on the tube
- Refrigerate the sample until it can be returned to the laboratory in the morning
