Post-Vasectomy Semen Analysis Collection Instructions for Patients

Patient Preparation:

- Your physician will advise you of the appropriate time to submit a semen specimen following vasectomy.
 - Providence Oregon Laboratory Services recommends that post-vasectomy semen be collected at least 12 weeks following the vasectomy procedure.
 - Avoid ejaculation for 2-3 days (but not more than 7 days) prior to collection.

Label the container with your first and last name, date of birth, and the date and time of collection.

Sample Collection:

- Collect a complete semen specimen by masturbation into a clean, sterile container obtained from your physician or laboratory.
 - Condoms are not acceptable.
- Deliver the specimen to the laboratory within 1 hour of collection.

Note: If you prefer to collect the specimen after arrival in the lab, a restroom is available.

Directions:

Enter through the Emergency Room entrance passing through the metal detector. Stop at the security desk and inform security of the need to drop off a specimen with the "Hospital Inpatient Lab".

Security will escort you to the Red Elevators and allow access to the second floor.

Upon exiting the elevator, pick up the phone next to the laboratory doors and notify the staff that you are there to drop off a sample.

Providence Milwaukie Inpatient Laboratory

Directions:

Enter using the Main Entrance and turn left to follow the signs for the Main Admitting desk. Use the kiosk to enter your patient information to check-in for the lab and wait to be called by the Registrar. The caregiver in admitting will contact the lab to accept the drop off sample.

Enter hospital via the main entrance and proceed to the front information desk (Access Services). Access services will call the inpatient lab to accept the drop off sample.

Providence Hood River Inpatient Laboratory 810 12th Street, Hood River, OR 97031 Directions:

Enter hospital via the main entrance and proceed to the front information desk (Access Services) on the left. Access services will call the inpatient lab to accept the drop off sample.
